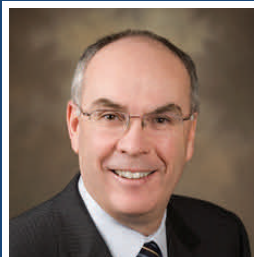
Allan Russell, P.Eng is the Chief Executive Officer and President of McElhanney Consulting Services Ltd.
